### About Gallery In The Garden

Gallery In The Garden ("GITG") is a two-day annual event that celebrates the synthesis of art in nature presented in a private garden. Located near historic downtown Woodstock, Illinois, Gallery In The Garden offers the public a unique opportunity to experience the work of local artists in a natural setting featuring a water garden, an oriental meditation garden and a variety of native and imported plantings. Founded in 2006 by Deb Glaubke, Gale Harris and Rob Glaubke, the three-quarter acre space was developed from a plain backyard to become the location of one of the most premiere and celebrated juried garden events in northern Illinois. ### About the charity Gallery In The Garden benefits

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of McHenry County is a non-profit organization whose mission is to draw from community resources to provide well-trained volunteers who will advocate for abused and neglected children in our court system, provide needed information to the court, and help develop a more effective juvenile court process. CASA, founded in 2005, provides trained volunteers to advocate for child victims of abuse and neglect in Juvenile Court and in the foster care system. CASA provides caring volunteers who make a life-long difference for children. These children have become involved in the Juvenile Court system because they are unable to live at homes, not because of something they did, but because their parents can't, or won't, take care of them. Volunteers are appointed by a judge and assigned to one case at a time, serving as an independent voice for abused and neglected children in court. Volunteers believe every child deserves to grow up in a safe and permanent home and they stay with a case until this goal is achieved. ### Eligibility

GITG is open to U.S. residents over 18 years of age. Residents under 18 are eligible with parental consent.

### Submission Fee

GITG requires a \$20, non-refundable application submission fee. All fees are used to support the promotion and operation of the event.

### Awards

GITG is not a competition; therefore no awards will be given. Artists will be judged by the jurors only for entry into the exhibition.

## Entry Procedure

1. Complete and sign the Entry Form.
2. Provide up to three photographs of your work. The photos can be either paper prints, digital on a CD, or emailed to debglaubke@comcast.net – in JPEG format only, please. Be sure the file names contain Artist's last name. (Example: "Harris\_pottery\_1.jpg")
3. Include a brief personal statement. For accepted artists, the statement and photos will be used on our website.
4. Mail Application Packet with a non-refundable check for \$20 payable to: Gallery In The Garden, 600 Lawndale Ave., Woodstock, IL 60098.

5. Do not send any original art. Nothing will be returned.

## Presentation

The exhibition space is in a private garden that varies in terrain, structures and lighting; therefore allotted spaces are not uniform. Artists should work with organizers to be sure they are allotted spaces based upon their artwork and unique presentation needs. In order to accommodate the artists and to maintain the aesthetics of the event, allotted spaces generally do not exceed 10'x10'. Art disciplines appropriate for GITG historically included painting, illustration, multi-media, sculpture and pottery, jewelry, printmaking, tapestry, woodworking and photography.

## Exhibition/Delivery

**Gallery in the Garden will be held Saturday, July 28 and Sunday, July 29. From 10:00am to 5:00pm at 600 Lawndale Ave, Woodstock, Illinois.** Rainout dates are set for Saturday, August 6 and Sunday, August 7. GITG asks Artists to be present and exhibit both days for all hours, some exceptions can be granted at the discretion of the organizers. Artists may load in their exhibits beginning Friday, July 29, at noon.

## Sales

Artists understand that they are responsible for their own sales and transactions in addition to adhering to any applicable local, state or federal tax laws. At the exhibition's conclusion, the Artist also agrees to make a contribution of 20% of total sales paid directly to Gallery In The Garden, of which, 100% will then be donated to the charity served by GITG. GITG's 2012 charity is Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of McHenry County.

## Raffle

Artists may also make a tax-deductible donation of artwork to the public raffle. The raffle is a popular event at GITG and proceeds go to GITG and it's charity, generating hundreds of extra donation dollars. Participation in the raffle is optional and has no bearing on Artist's acceptance into GITG.

## Liability

GITG, its officers, third party vendors, and/or participating land owner partners (neighbors), are not liable for any loss, theft, damage or deterioration of artwork before, during or after the exhibition. The Artist assumes responsibility for their property during on- and off-hours of the exhibition, whether the property remains on GITG premises or not. The Artist further acknowledges that the exhibition takes place outdoors and therefore their property will be subjected to natural elements. GITG does not provide protection from the elements. Insurance coverage for Artists' property is the responsibility of the Artist.

## Media Release

By participating in GITG, the Artist gives GITG consent to use their name, personal statement, and/or images or video of their artwork or likeness for the sole purpose of promoting GITG. The Artist understands that there will be no compensation for the use of images and that the images could be circulated worldwide in forums such as Web sites, online or print publications, broadcast media and marketing materials. Artists releases GITG from any liability resulting from the use of images.
